It's an exciting year! Because of construction in Dover-Foxcroft we're moving the Festival to the Piscataquis Valley Fairgrounds! It means more space, more parking, and more whoopie! See you there!

- We give YOU **\$50** per space (up to 2 spaces) at the festival.
- As an incentive to register soon, we'll give you a \$100 bonus if you register by April 1st.
- We'll give you .20 for every sample you give out
- Cash prizes for our judged and people's choice contests are: 1st: \$125, 2nd: \$75, 3rd: \$50
- AND you'll get amazing exposure, lots of publicity, and the chance to sell whoopie pies to thousands and thousands of hungry customers.

Details:

- 1. This may seem obvious, but you have to be at the festival to get paid.
- You'll get your check within 2 weeks of the festival date.
 - Proceeds from the festival go to support the Center Theatre and its mission to engage and inspire by making the arts, education, and entertainment accessible to our rural communities. The Theatre will gratefully accept your donation if you want to waive any of your payments. You will receive a donation letter for your taxes.



Contest Details



Yankee Whoopie Prize: Created by long-time festival judge and whoopie pie aficionado, Jim Bailey the Yankee Chef, the Yankee Whoopie Prize celebrates the best use of true Yankee ingredients. The Yankee Whoopie Prize will be judged on its use and creativity of one or more of the following ingredients: Pumpkin, Blueberry Pie, Coffee, including espresso and mocha (after New England's own Autocrat coffee), Cranberries. Needham (best representing flavor of Needhams and use of potato) The winner receives a Yankee Chef prize package valued at \$200.

People's Choice Award: We will be selecting the People's Choice Award by text voting. Attendees will text (877)732-4075 with your baker name to vote for you as their favorite baker. We will provide one 11x17 sign for your booth with this information, but please feel free to make other signage yourself. We will have staff who will scan incoming votes and correctly tally misspellings and variations in your name. The People's Choice Voting will close at 3pm and winners will be announced by 4pm. Only attendees at the 2025 Maine Whoopie Pie Festival are eligible to vote by text for the People's Choice Awards. We will be scanning social media and any bakers encouraging voting by fans outside the festival will be eliminated from the contest. No exceptions.

All Bakers will also receive a wooden plague after the festival. It will list their awards and/or celebrate their Festival participation!

Baker Contest Procedures

- In order to ensure speedy set-up and judging, we will be contacting all bakers the week before the festival to find out what categories you will be entering and what whoopie pies you will be submitting for judging.
- While setting up, volunteers will collect your entries for the *Best* Traditional, Best Flavored, Healthy Whoopie Prize, Yankee Whoopie Pie, and Best Allen's Coffee Brandy Whoopie Pie. You may enter **ONE** Whoopie Pie in each category. You don't have to enter all categories.
- New Bakers will designate one of their submitted whoopie pies to be considered for the "Best New Baker" award.
- Bakers may submit an entry for the Most Creative Whoopie Pie Name to the volunteer. This must be the name of a whoopie pie being sold at the festival. However, bakers do not have to submit the whoopie pie itself just the name.
- Winners will be announced the afternoon of the festival. We will also visit each winner's booth to give you the good news.
- Please Be Kind to Our Judges: These awards are determined by our panel of volunteer judges based on their own standards of Whoopie Pie Excellence. They have a very difficult job, so please do not make it harder by a accosting them if their opinion differs from yours.

Procedures for Samples and Tokens

Festival attendees will receive tokens (wooden nickels) when they enter the festival and can purchase more for .25 each. They will bring these tokens to you, the bakers, and exchange them for a sample of a whoopie pie. The size of the sample is entirely up to you. You should give them enough of a taste that they'll want to buy some Whoopie Pies to take home, but keep it small enough that you don't run out too soon. During the festival, volunteers will collect your tokens to recycle throughout the day. Within 24 hours of the end of the festival, we will email you a short questionnaire about the festival, including how many samples you gave out in total. We will reimburse you 20 cents for every sample. You will receive the check 1-2 weeks after the festival.
